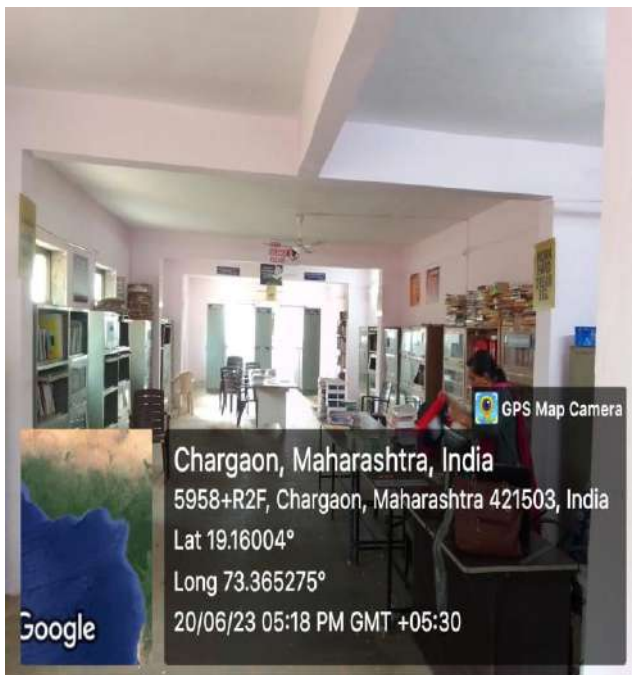

Ms. Ashwini Ingale chaired this session. This was rather an interactive session. The participants enjoyed well in this session.

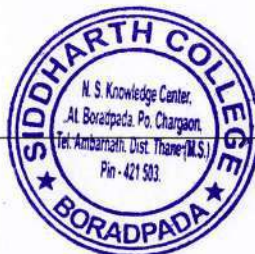
The eyes of many who attended were opened after the sessions conducted by Adv. Roshan. He was excellent in presenting the concepts clearly.

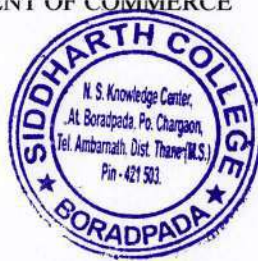
Certificates were distributed the participants by the hands of the Resource Person and the Principal. Feedback Forms were distributed and collected from the participants.

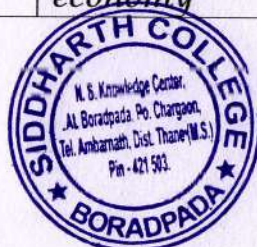

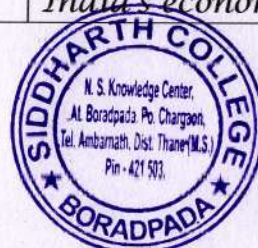
