# A Report on "Construction of Irrigation\ Bandhara"

#### Activity Details:

Department of Commerce, NSS Siddharth College of BMM,BMS and BCom Organized construction of irrigation and Bunds in Kurhadpada Montains, Hills area. Bandhara irrigation is a minor irrigation system suitable for irrigating isolated areas, up to 100 acres. The bandhara is similar to weir which is constructed across a small stream to raise the water level on the upstream side to divert the water through the canal.

#### ADVANTAGES OF BANDHARA IRRIGATION:

- 1) The water of small streams can be utilized for irrigation purpose by constructing a simple structure.
- The culturable area is generally close to the source. Hence, there is less possibility of transmission loss.
- 3) As there is no loss due to transmission, the duty of water is high.

#### Outcomes:

- Surrounding area is very near to the weir so the canal is of short length so transition loss of water is less and it also affects the intensive irrigation.
- Small catchment area covered in weir so wastage of will be utilized fully







#### REPORT ON One Day Workshop

on "Vermi Compost & Water Harveting"

Department of Botany & NSS with coordination if IQAC. conducted One day workshop on Vermi Compost and Water Harvesting for the under graduate and post graduate students on 21 December, 2022. The Resource person of this programme was Mr. Sachin Torve (Agriculture Asst.) and Avinash Vadate Agriculture Supervisor) Ambernath.. Chairman of this programme is Hon.Nagesh S.Jadhav . On the given speech Mr. Avinash Vadate and Mr. Sachin Torve says Vermicomposting is known to be the world's best fertilizer. Vermicomposting is a method of preparing enriched compost with the use earthworms. It is one of the earliest methods to recycle agricultural waste and to produce quality compost. Vermicomposting is stable, fine granular organic manure, which enriches soil quality by improving its physiochemical and biological properties. It is highly useful in raising seedlings and for crop production. Vermicomposting is becoming popular as a major component of organic farming system. Raw material needed for Vermicomposting are: 1. Cow dung 2. Straw 3. Dry leaves 4. Water

5. Soil 6. Gunny Bag










#### Collection of Raw Materials:

- Collection of Cow Dung: Cow Dung was collected in a cow shed in a nearby village from the vermicompost pit. Around 30 bags of cow dung was taken from the shed and carried by the college vehicle to the compost pit.
- Collection of Dry Leaves: Dried leaves were collected in a large amount in the forest (Tangnuam) a little farther away from the vermicompost pit and it was carried by the college vehicle upto the compost pit
- Collection of earthworm and straw: Earthworm and straws are collected by the students independently from different places and brought to the college with their own transport system.
- Collection of Soil: Soil was collected within the campus itself and is carried using the college rickshaw as the distance to the compost pit was short distanced.
- 5. Water: Water was already available in the college campus so it was taken from the college itself

#### Purpose:

- · Reduce surface water flow velocity
- Enhance infiltration, thereby recharging soil moisture and groundwater
- Prevent soil erosion and washing-out of nutrients
- · Prevent silting of water bodies

#### Objectives:

The main objectives of this project is to provide water throughout most of the year 90% farmers in selected vulnerable areas in dry zone, through property maintenance of minor irrigation bund system.

Contour bunds and contour trenches prevent soil erosion by intercepting surface water runoff. They are constructed along lines of equal elevation (contour lines) at a right angle to the slope of a plot of land.







 Construct a level crop field that can be easily worked Terraces, contour bunds and trenches should ideally be implemented in combination with other practices of sustainable agriculture, such as agroforestry, farmer managed natural regeneration (FMNR) and sustainable rangeland management.
